Evans-Brant Central School District Using Comet Tracker to Improve Safety of the Students

Profile

Evans-Brant Central School District has a legacy of operations dating back more than 50 years. The School District is governed by the Board of Education, which is responsible for the general management and control of the District's financial and educational affairs. They currently have 7 schools in their district and 80 buses. Approximately 100 employees are responsible for transporting more than 3000 students.

Challenges
