Myla Eldridge

An experienced and committed public servant, Myla A. Eldridge was sworn in as Marion County Auditor on January 1, 2023. In this role, Eldridge is charged with managing the county's finances, including its revenues, and expenditures, distributing taxes to governmental units and agencies for which they were collected, and processing the payroll for all city and county employees in Marion County.

Prior to her election as Marion County Auditor, Eldridge served two terms as County Clerk. The first African American to serve in that office, Eldridge increased access to voting, improved customer service, simplified how residents file court cases, and oversaw the county's historic transition to vote centers in 2019.

As Auditor, Eldridge is focused on increasing efficiency and transparency throughout the office. Specifically, she is working to digitize invoices to reduce the reliance on printing paper, upgrading technology to automate more processes and reduce human error, and will work with the City of Indianapolis, making it easier and increasing opportunities for small and minority/women-owned businesses to compete for public contracts.
