The Marion County Public Defender Agency provides legal representation for Marion County citizens who cannot afford to hire their own lawyer in matters involving liberty interests, including criminal cases. Our services are provided as a public service. We work with the felony, misdemeanor, Title IV D, civil commitment and juvenile courts. We also work on cases related to termination of parental rights as well as appeals.

Our agency also offers education, services, and programs focused on different ways to serve jail sentences. Our office is led by Chief Public Defender Raymond Casanova who is assisted by Chief Counsel Ann Sutton and Chief Trial Deputy Deana Martin.
