The Department of Public Works, is responsible for construction, renovation, and the operation of City facilities and infrastructure. Facilities include the Los Angeles International Airport, City Hall, Hyperion and Tillman Treatment Plants, Hyperion and park facilities. Infrastructure includes streets, bridges, sewers, and storm drains. The Board of Public Works Commissioners are the chief administrators of the Department of Public Works, overseeing the design and execution of department projects. They are the City's only full time, policy-making board, serving as the General Manager of the Department of Public Works. The Board is an executive team composed of five members, selected and appointed by the Mayor of Los Angeles, and confirmed by the City Council to five-year terms.
