Mission:

Act No. 1 of June 23, 1985, as amended on August 13, 1990, created the Volunteer Corps in the Service of Puerto Rico. Reorganization Plan 2 of May 4, 1994, reorganized the Department of Labor and Human Resources and assigned this agency to the Department as an operational component. Act No. 224 of August 6, 1999, changed the agency's name to the Administration for the Training of Future Entrepreneurs and Workers and established new functions and other public purposes. Combat youth unemployment between the ages of 14 and 29 through the development of innovative programs that combine technical-vocational training, education, and training to enable them to obtain employment and integrate them productively into the community. Additionally, provide retraining and employment services to displaced workers through a focus on life skills development and human development, employability competencies, remedial education, and occupational training to reintegrate them into the workforce.
