### Mission:

Act No. 118 of July 22, 1974, as amended, created the Board as a quasi-judicial agency of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico. Reorganization Plan No. 3 of December 9, 1993, created the Department of Correction and Rehabilitation and assigned the Parole Board to it as an operational component. Act No. 151 of October 31, 2001, amends several sections of Act No. 118, and repeals Act No. 114 of July 6, 2000, and renames this body the Parole Board. Administer, investigate, and grant a conditional release system as a means of rehabilitation for inmates so that, upon meeting the established requirements, they may be considered for the enjoyment of the privilege of parole in the free community.
