## Mission:

Act No. 207 of May 14, 1948, as amended, creates the Puerto Rico Corporation of Industries for the Blind, amended by Act No. 127 of June 24, 1968, to change its name to Corporation of Industries for the Blind, Mentally Retarded Persons, and Other Disabled Persons of Puerto Rico. Reorganization Plan Number 1, approved on July 28, 1995, by the Legislative Assembly, attaches the Corporation to the Department of the Family and instructs an analysis of the public corporation and a determination of its status within the new organizational structure of the Department. Provide means for the social and economic rehabilitation of blind persons, mentally retarded persons, and other persons with disabilities in Puerto Rico, through paid employment opportunities in non-profit workshops dedicated to the production of items for sale to the public.
