Act No. 74 of June 23, 1965, as amended, created the Highway Authority. Act No. 4 of August 24, 1990, authorized it to enter into contracts with private entities for the construction, operation, and maintenance of roads, bridges, avenues, highways, and other transit facilities. Act No. 1 of March 6, 1991, renamed it the Puerto Rico Highway and Transportation Authority. The purpose of the Authority is to provide the Puerto Rican people with an integrated, efficient, reliable, and safe transportation system that contributes to the development of Puerto Rico's economy and improves its quality of life. The Authority is to develop excellent government management that fosters public trust.
