Act No. 154 of August 1988, as amended, "Organic Law of the Administration of Juvenile Institutions." Act No. 88 of July 9, 1986, known as the "Juveniles Law," establishes in section (b) of Article 35 the right of each juvenile to receive individualized services or treatment that respond to their needs and promote their eventual rehabilitation. In accordance with Reorganization Plan Number 3 of December 9, 1993, the Administration of Juvenile Institutions is assigned as an operational component of the Department of Correction and Rehabilitation. Its functions are to protect public safety, hold juveniles accountable for their offenses, and provide them with appropriate services to develop the skills necessary to return to the free community.
