Mission:

Act No. 17 of April 19, 1955, as amended, grants the name Ports Authority to the agency created by Act 125 of May 7, 1942, which was previously known as the Transportation Authority. The Ports Authority is governed by Reorganization Plan No. 6 of 1971. This reorganization plan separates the Ports Authority from the Economic Development Administration and assigns it to the Department of Transportation and Public Works. In turn, the powers, authorities, and functions that the Economic Development Administrator and the members of the Authority have with respect to the Ports Authority, in accordance with the organic law of said Authority and other special laws that assign it functions, are transferred to the Secretary of Transportation and Public Works. The Ports Authority provides industrial, commercial, and tourism workers, as well as the public, with services related to air and maritime transportation to contribute to the development of Puerto Rico's economic infrastructure.
