Law No. 177 of August 12, 1995, created the Office of Pretrial Services as an autonomous entity attached to the Department of Correction and Rehabilitation. The Office of Pretrial Services evaluates defendants charged with bailable offenses and submits verifiable information to the judge regarding the defendant's criminal record and sociological and socioeconomic profile. This information provides an accurate and reliable recommendation for the court to determine the appropriate provisional release measure. It establishes a reliable monitoring system that guarantees community safety and the appearance of the defendant during the judicial process while on provisional release. It establishes a plan of conditions aimed at contributing to the client's rehabilitation.
