Mission:

Act 323 of December 28, 2003, as amended, created the Puerto Rico Trade and Export Company (CCE), a public corporation attached to the Puerto Rico Department of Economic Development and Commerce (known in English as the Puerto Rico Trade and Export Company). Act 323, supra, established the powers and duties of the CCE, transferred the operations and assets of the Trade Development Administration and the Puerto Rico Export Development Corporation to this new corporation. The Trade and Export Company is the government entity that establishes public policy regarding the development of trade, with an emphasis on small and medium-sized businesses, involving all productive sectors of the Island, including non-profit organizations, to ensure their competitiveness both locally and internationally, with the purpose of strengthening Puerto Rico's economy and promoting the creation and retention of jobs.
